DEPARTMENTAL ACTIVITIES

Department of English



An online workshop on “Understanding Cultural Nuances in Translation” was organised by the PG Department of English on 22nd May 2021. The resource person, Dr Hina Nandrajog, Principal Vivekananda College, is two times recipient of Katha Prize for translation and the coveted Sahitya Academy Prize in translation for the

On 9th June 2021, the department also organized a virtual interaction with Padma Shri Mohammad Ali Baig, an internationally renowned figure in the field of film and theatre and the only Indian to have been invited to perform at Edinburgh Theatre Festival and at Oxford University. His plays have been performed at Kala Ghoda Art Festival Mumbai. Nearly 200 participants joined on



the Zoom platform as well on the Facebook page where it was streamed live. Known as the "Master of Epics" and the "Sultan of Revival", Mohammad Ali Baig has 450 productions to his credit and more than 40 national and international awards from countries like France, Canada, UK, USA, Turkey.

Department of Economics
